Covenant of Welcome

We welcome ALL to our congregation and uphold the dignity and worth of all persons. We extend the love of Jesus Christ to everyone including those who are marginalized for any reason such as: age, race, gender, education, marital status, sexual orientation, socioeconomic status, political viewpoint, immigration status, gender identity, disability, national origin, or religious belief.

This Covenant of Welcome was adopted by the Fort Collins Community of Christ after two years of prayer, study, and discernment surrounding one of the core beliefs of the denomination—“*The Worth of All Persons.*”

With this action we officially became a member of the Welcoming Community Network (WCN). WCN assists Community of Christ congregations in the process of education, prayer, study, and discernment around LGBT issues.



We are part of an international Christian church with 250,000 members found in more than fifty nations. Our International Headquarters, including a Temple dedicated to the pursuit of peace, is located in Independence, Missouri.
